



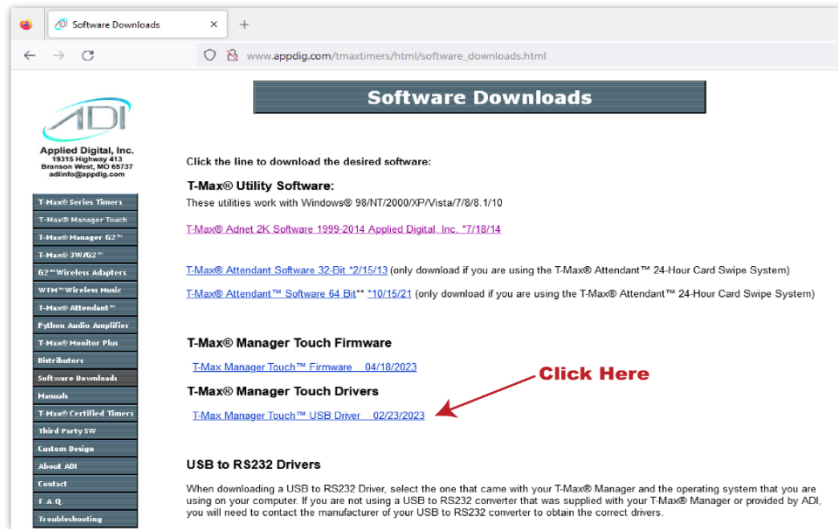

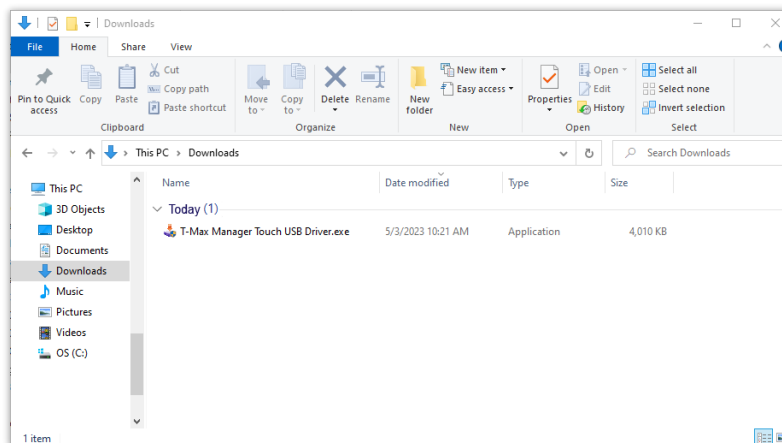

Select T-Max® Manager Touch™ USB Driver indicated by the Click Here Arrow.

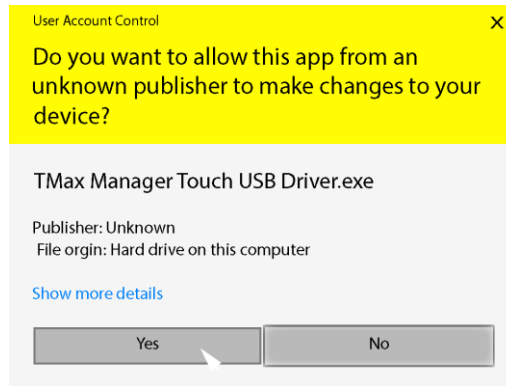
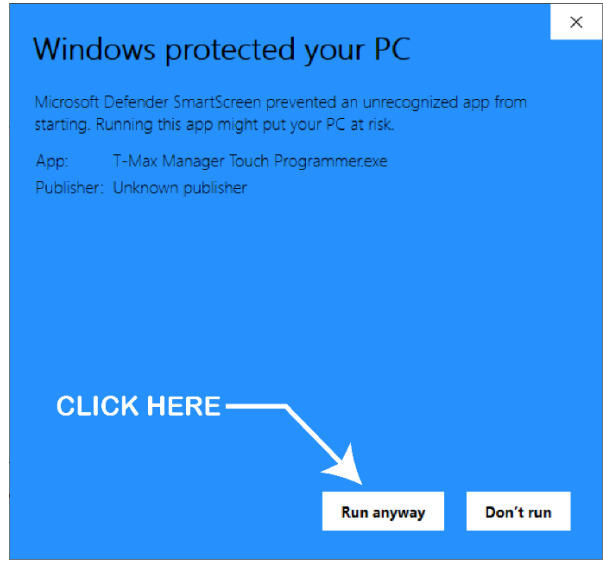
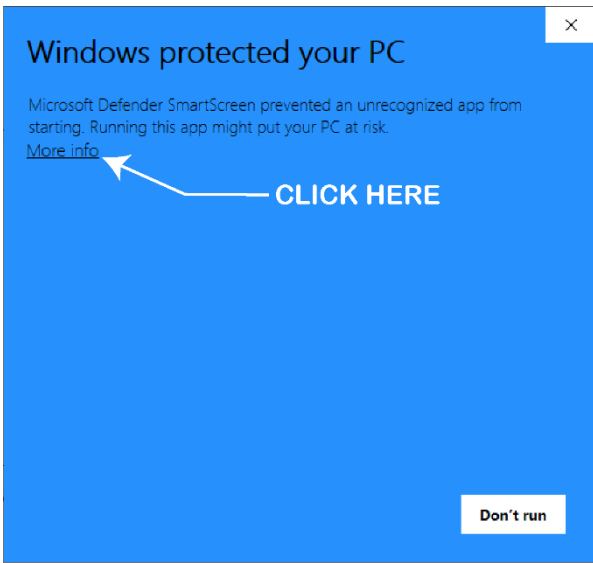
A message will appear asking you to save the file. Save the file. This message will appear different depending on which internet browser you are using. Next go to your Download folder using Windows File Explorer:



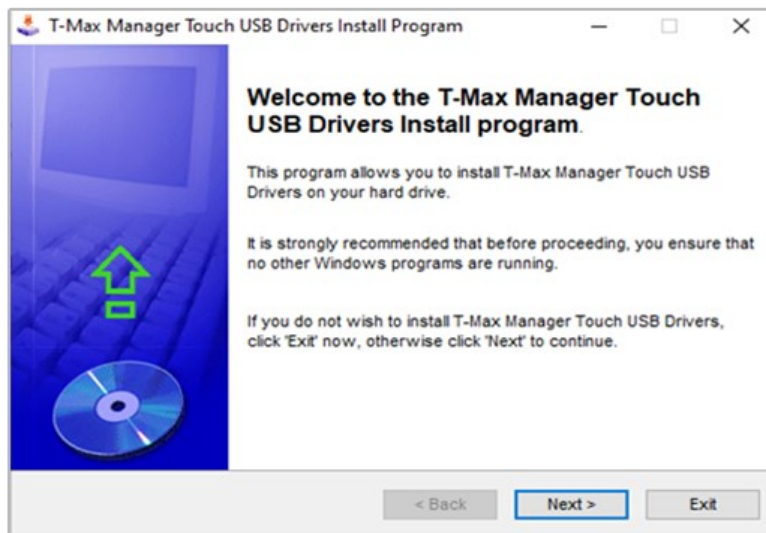
Double click T-Max® Manager Touch™ USB Driver. One of the following screens will appear:

Click Exit. The message will go away.

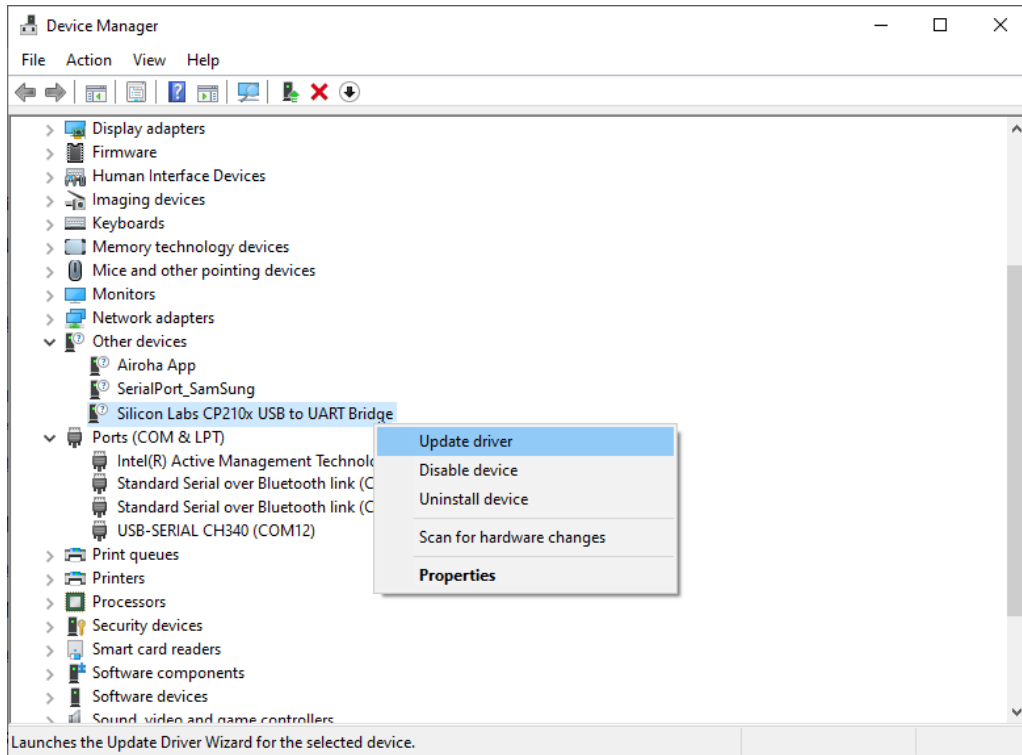
Next, go to the device manager on your computer.



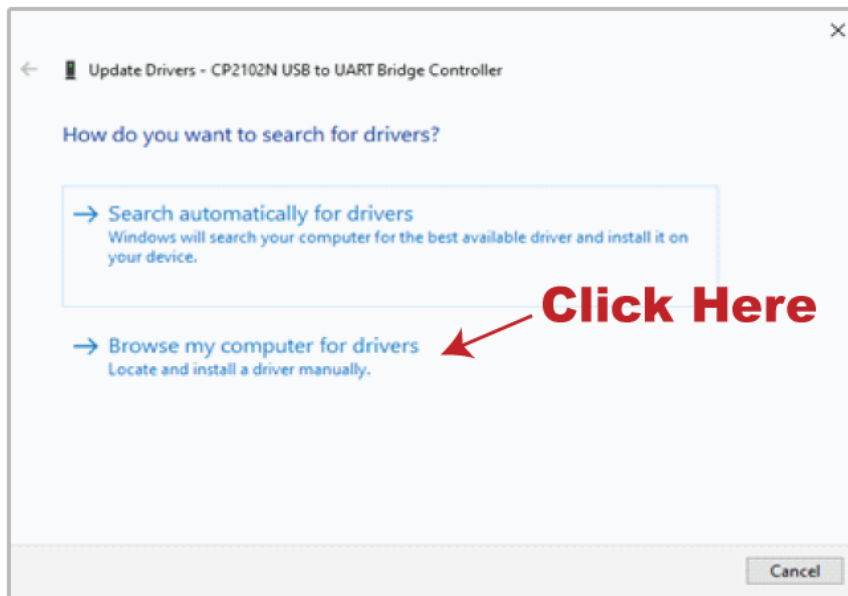

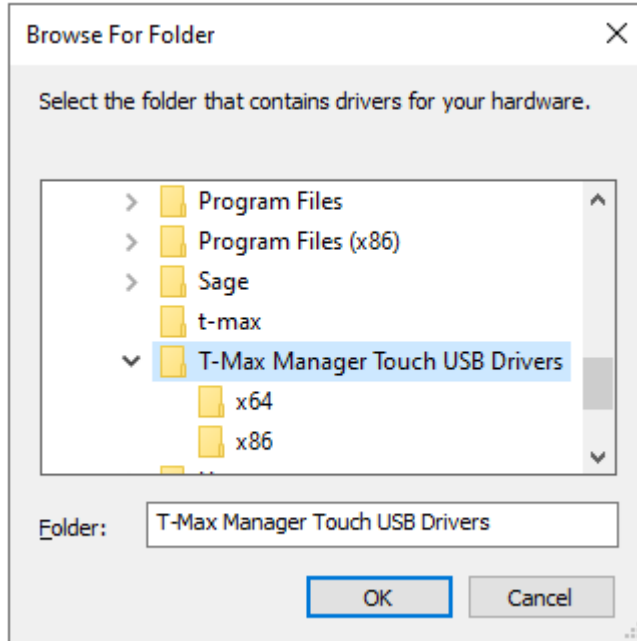


Select Browse, then This PC, Local Disk (C:)

In some computers, the C drive may be labeled as Windows (C:) or OS (C:)

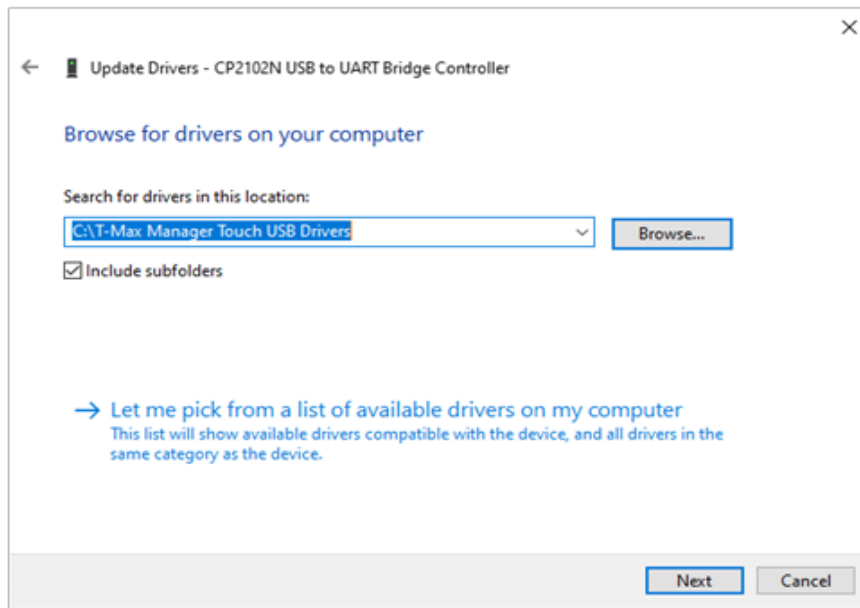

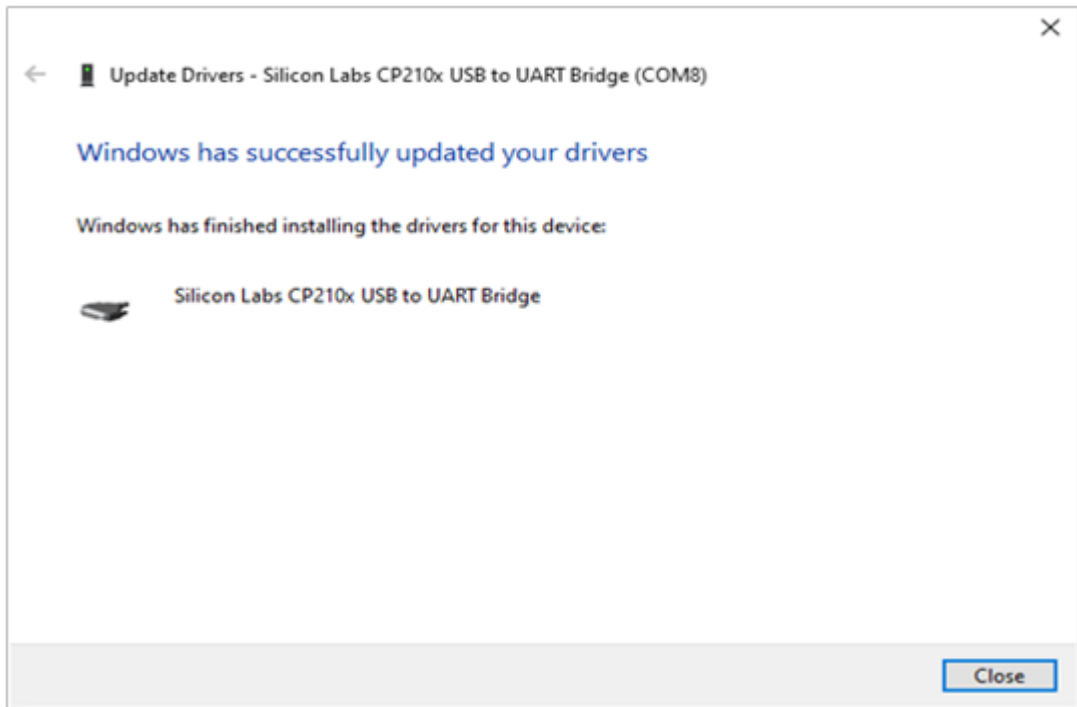


Scroll down and select to the folder labeled T-Max® Manager Touch™ USB Drivers.

The following window will appear:



Click next. After a short delay showing the drivers being installed, the following window will appear:



Click Close. Go back to the device manager and click the arrow to the left of Ports.

The port your T-Max® Manager Touch™ will use will appear as Silicon Labs CP210x USB to UART Bridge (Com #). The # will be a number that the port is assigned to (this the screen above; COM 8).

Installation is complete. Configure your tanning software to communicate to the T-Max® that the Silicon Labs CP210x port is configured to.
